

A Few Things to Remember When You Apply for an NCC Scholarship or Award

All applications must be submitted online (www.ncc.edu/scholarships) by 11:59 p.m. on Wednesday, October 23, 2019.

Each scholarship and award has different eligibility criteria. The online application system has a list of available scholarships and requirements. Read the criteria carefully as they may vary between applications.

All of the following must be included with each online application and submitted by the deadline date:

1. General information (initial page of the online application)
2. The student's signature and date (bottom of the general information page on the online application)
3. Additional scholarship specific information (available after choosing a specific scholarship)
4. A typed essay (adhere to topic and length requirements)
5. All required verification letters if stated on the application

Note:

Scholarship winners must be in good academic standing

Applications submitted with incomplete information will be disqualified.



Frequently Asked Questions

What kind of help can I get for my application?

Will the GPA from another school be used to calculate GPA requirements for scholarships and awards? *No, only the NCC GPA that you have earned from NCC for all of your courses will be counted.*

May a student apply for more than one award each semester? *As long as a student fulfills all of the eligibility criteria, there is no limit to the number of scholarships for which he or she may apply.*

Are international students eligible for NCC scholarships and awards? *Yes, as long as a student fulfills all of the eligibility criteria, all students, including international students, may apply for awards and scholarships.*

Will I be notified if I win a scholarship or award? *Applicants should check the website approximately ten weeks after the application deadline dates to determine if they won a scholarship. Winners will be invited to the NCC Awards Ceremony.*

Some scholarships require that the student demonstrate financial need. How is that done? *Financial need is determined by your FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) results. You must have filed a FAFSA and all required documents must be reviewed and satisfied with the Financial Aid Office prior to submitting your scholarship application. It is recommended that you fill out the application online at www.fafsa.ed.gov (school code: 002873). (Please note: late submission of financial aid documents may take several weeks to process).*

Do I have to apply online? *Yes. All applications must be submitted through the online process.*

How do I get help with the online application system? *Contact scholarships@ncc.edu with any questions. Please provide specific information about the problem you are having. If you have a documented disability and need help filling out the application online please contact Donna Sparberg in the CSD office at 516-572-7241.*

General Information

Student scholarships and awards are offered at Nassau Community College during both the Fall and Spring semesters.

Evaluation of submitted applications is conducted by a committee of faculty members.

Scholarship applications are available online at www.ncc.edu/scholarships.

Applicants should check the website approximately ten weeks after the application deadline dates to determine if they won a scholarship. **Please do not phone to inquire about the status of your application after it has been submitted.** Committee members are not permitted to discuss results.
