Academic, Student Affairs & Enrollment Committee Meeting Minutes

May 9, 2023

The meeting of the Academic, Student Affairs & Enrollment Committee of the Board of Trustees was held on the eleventh floor of the Administrative Tower. The meeting was called to order by Trustee Tuman at 5:45 p.m.

1. Approval of Minutes

Trustee Tuman requested a motion to approve the minutes of February 9, 2023. Trustee Weiss moved the motion; seconded by Trustee D'Agostino. Motion carried 4-0.

2. Enrollment Updates

Registrar Barkan presented the Summer 2023 report comparing May 7, 2023 to May 8, 2022, which reveals a decrease of 1.2% in credits and 2.29% in head count. At this time last year, summer enrollment was down 21%. Fall registration shows an increase of 12.46% in credits and 11.37% in head count. Last year at this time, Fall enrollment was down 11.66%. The Registrar's office continues its outreach to attract students with mailings and text reminders to continuing students and new non-degree and visiting students.

Asst. VP Follick presented the Fall new student enrollment trends, comparing May 5, 2023 to May 8, 2022, showing an increase in first-year and transfer applications but decrease in admitted students. There is an increase in applications across the SUNY sector, which is contributed to the student vaccine mandate being dropped. Roughly 957 students have been tested through May 5, 2023, with on-campus placement testing being the preferred modality. Ongoing discussions with Chair Kaplan, Acting VP Alvarez, Acting Dean Deal, and Asst. VP Follick regarding potential waivers for prospective students to be waived from the math placement test.

Applications are up for concurrent enrollment, through which high school students take their senior year at NCC. Meetings with Superintendents/high school administration continue as word is spreading about Concurrent Enrollment opportunity throughout Nassau County. Dual enrollment conversations continue with the World Languages and Math departments.

Trustee Tuman asked if there were any other items for the Committee to consider. There being none, the meeting adjourned at 6:00 p.m.
