Academic, Student Affairs & Enrollment Committee Meeting Minutes

January 22, 2025

The meeting of the Academic, Student Affairs & Enrollment Committee of the Board of Trustees was held in the College Center Building rooms 252-253. The meeting was called to order by Trustee Tuman at 5:18 p.m.

1. Approval of Minutes

Trustee Tuman requested a motion to approve the minutes of December 10, 2024. Trustee Groom moved the motion; seconded by Trustee D'Agostino. Motion carried 4-0.

2. Academic Affairs: Middle States

VP Alvarez-Ortiz reported that the Self-Study report was submitted along with 115 evidentially documents to Middle States capturing an honest reflection of NCC and where we can be in the future. The Middle States Steering committee did an excellent job and she thanked Dr. Conzatti for her support and feedback. As a reminder, the Middle States Team visit is scheduled from March 9 – 12, 2025.

3. Enrollment Updates

Asst. VP Follick presented the enrollment report revealing for Winter 2025 census comparing January 6, 2025 to January 6, 2024 reporting an increase of 12.71% in credits and 10.70% in head count. Spring 2025 semester comparing January 21, 2025 to January 19, 2024, 6 days prior to the start of the spring semester, reveals an increase of 4.29% in credits and 3.35% in head count and comparing January 21, 2025 to January 21, 2024 reveals a decrease in applications for non-degree and visiting students but an increase in non-degree and visiting registered students.

The registrar's office sends out regular communications via Slate using both text and email to students. Summer 2025 registration begins on March 10, 2025.

For Spring First-year students enrollment trends for the past 3 years show an overall increase in registered, transfer and re-admit students.

Trustee Tuman adjourned the meeting at 5:25 p.m.
