

NCC offers an extensive selection of academic, social, cultural and recreational activities to enrich the college experience. From a distinguished honors program and tutoring centers to more than 200 student activities and events each year, you will always have access to excellence at the college.

Honors Program

The Carol Farber Honors Program is a community of academically exceptional students with a high school GPA of 88 or higher. The program is designed to provide unique learning experiences, off-campus travel, access to academic conferences and competitions, and coveted internships.

Tutoring Centers

The Writing and Math Centers offer individualized and group student support with tutorial services and assistance in research.

Arthur O. Eve Educational Opportunity Program

The Educational Opportunity Program is jointly sponsored by the State University of New York and NCC. EOP provides academic support and financial assistance to students who show promise for succeeding in college but have limited financial resources.

Center for Students with Disabilities

The mission of the Center for Students with Disabilities is to serve students with documented disabilities by providing them with resources and support. It assists students with advisement, appropriate classroom and testing accommodations, sign language interpreters, assisted learning devices and adaptive computer access.

Career Counseling Center

Students receive assistance with job and internship placements, resume development and job interview skills.

WHPC Radio Station

The College's award-winning radio station, WHPC, provides professional broadcast training to qualified students. The station can be heard at 90.3 FM and nationwide and is the only college radio station in Nassau and Suffolk to broadcast in high definition.

Plaza Art Gallery
