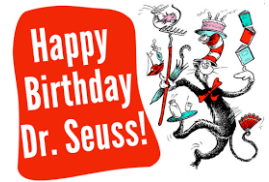


Toddler Two Group

Favorite Books and Authors Centerwide Author - Eric Carle



Cognitive Development:

- We will introduce the children to stories about a child's world written and illustrated by Eric Carle.

Art:

- After reading Little Cloud, the children will help illustrate the book to hang on the Favorite Books and Authors mural.
- After reading Today Is Monday, the children will glue pictures of different foods onto a paper plate.

Discovery:

- In the dramatic play area, we will have a variety of toy fruits and vegetables for the children to have a picnic with.
- Talk about/show pictures of different body parts.

Math Skills:

- Sort and count toy vegetables and fruit.

Special Event:

- **Friday, March 2nd - Dr. Seuss' Birthday/Read Across America Day**

We will celebrate with a center wide story time.

Gross Motor Skills:

- Using masking tape we will create a spider web on the floor and have the children tip toe around the web.
- As we blow bubbles, we will call out different body parts and have them pop the bubbles with that body part.

Fine Motor Skills:

- Play with rubber ducks in the water table.
- String beads
