Topics: <u>Snowflakes/Winter/Winter Clothing</u>

Cognitive Development: We will talk about:

- the season of winter and what the weather is like in the winter.
- the types of clothing we wear in the cold weather. The children will help "dress" a bear in winter clothing.

Vocabulary words: winter, snow, snowflakes, cold, weather, coat, hat, mittens, scarf and boots.

Fine Motor Skills/Art: Each child will:

- make a unique snowflake to hang on the Winter Mural in the preschool gym.
- decorate a pair of mittens to hang on our *Mitten Tree* in the preschool gym.

Gross Motor Skills:

• The children will throw "snowballs" (cotton balls) around the room.

Social/Emotional Development:

• encourage the children to share and take turns.
