

MENTORING IN MEDICINE








STEP students were invited by Adelphi University, in partnership with Mentoring in Medicine, Inc., to participate in a day of medical science and exploration. Students learned how they can enter into a health or science career while helping to increase the diversity in biomedical careers, a field that has historically been underrepresented by African Americans, Latinos, American Indians and Native Alaskans, along with people from underserved communities. On March 19th, 2022, NCC STEP students were offered access to human patient and pediatric simulators, CPR classes, live dissections and much more. At the end of their day of Mentoring in Medicine students received a "Community Health Ambassador Program" certificate and a new take on the endless possibilities of joining the medical field of careers!



SEWANHAKA STEP STUDENTS MEET NASA'S GINGER KERRICK!

Sewanhaka STEP students and their teacher Mr. Botka, met the extremely talented and down to earth Ms. Ginger Kerrick who is best known for being NASA's first Hispanic Female Flight Director. Her career is also highlighted for being the first non-astronaut Capsule Communicator (Capcom) and the first Russian-training-integration instructor. At the Cradle of Aviation, she shared with students her moving and personal narrative of growing up in Texas from modest means, losing her father at age 11 and yet never forgetting to work hard on her dreams. When asked who is her biggest inspiration and mentor, she shares proudly that it has always been her mother. Students asked questions and had the opportunity to pose for a snap with this amazing woman of science!
