

A Sample of Industry Applications:

Construction: Whether they're used for surveying, to show clients and potential clients an aerial overview of completed projects, to monitor jobsites to ensure safe practices or to inspect bridges and other structures, drones have the potential to become as important a tool to the industry as any piece of yellow iron.

Fire Fighting: NASA and the Forest Service tested using a Predator to find and map forest fires in California.

Law Enforcement: Some police departments are testing them for uses such as photographing accident sites and finding criminal suspects.

DRONES: INTRODUCTION & COMMERCIAL ASPECTS OF UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYSTEMS (UAS)

Students will be introduced to and become familiar with the integral components and operation of a typical drone. To provide a broad understanding of the Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAV) Industry and the commercial operation and uses of drones, both classroom and hands-on learning with Drone Lab "flying time" will be utilized. Students will also be introduced to current and future perspectives of UAS/UAV's. Topics will include: the development of unmanned aircraft systems with respect to commercial uses; federal responsibility; the path to commercial operations with and without a pilot's license; the UAS Industry and various trade and industry organizations. No prior experience necessary. Pilots welcome!

Required equipment is additional cost. If purchasing, a Drone/UAV-SYMA X5C-1 or other version of the SYMA X5 series is suggested.
