WHAT WILL YOU DO?

CSOs work alongside Public Safety Officers and assist with a variety of campus safety activities, including:

- Assisting officers with patrols of campus buildings and grounds
- Assisting with emergency drills, simulations, fire drills, and training exercises
- Supporting special events, student activities, and crowd control
- Performing ID checks and serving as the eyes and ears of Public Safety in a non-enforcement role
- Helping with campus safety signage and Lost & Found
- Assisting with safety work orders and department paperwork
- Helping organize log book entries and maintain log book supplies
- Welcoming and assisting visitors and guests at the Public Safety front desk
- Providing students with information about Public Safety services and campus events

WHO SHOULD APPLY?

Students who are:

- Eligible for **Federal Work-Study**
- 18 years of age or older
- Interested in law enforcement, emergency management, security, or public safety
- Dependable, professional, physically fit, and team-oriented
- Willing to complete required Public Safety training

NO SECURITY GUARD LICENSE IS REQUIRED TO APPLY.

Uniformed Position – Required training will be provided.

WHY BECOME A CSO?

Gain practical experience in public safety operations, emergency preparedness, communication, customer service, and event safety — all while supporting the Nassau Community College Public Safety Department.

Successful candidates may also become eligible for 3 college credits for life experience.
