Policy on Professional Course Transfer & Advanced Standing

Due to the differences in course content and timing between schools and programs, as well as the need to directly evaluate current student knowledge and skills taught in didactic, laboratory and clinical settings, the Respiratory Care Program at Nassau Community College (NCC) does not accept Respiratory Care courses and/or credits from other Respiratory Care programs as an NCC Respiratory Care Program core course equivalent, or offer transfer students automatic “advanced” Program standing for coursework completed at other institutions or for holding the National Board for Respiratory Care (NBRC) Certified Respiratory Therapist (CRT) credential.

Prospective transfer students are reminded that Nassau Community College maintains a “residency” requirement whereby a minimum of 33 credits towards any degree must be attained at the NCC Garden City, New York, campus.
