Select an artwork and identify any symbols you recognize, possibly connecting recurring symbols in multiple artworks, or a symbol that is personal to you. Name the symbol(s) and explain your impression of the meaning(s). Remember to cite the artist's name and the title of the work in your answer.

4. Skill and creativity are important components in art. Select a piece of artwork that best represents both: (A) creativity, (B) skill. Explain the reason(s) for your choice. Remember to give the artist's name and title of the piece in your answer.

5. Choose an artwork that you would award "Best in Show" and explain the reasons for your choice. Remember to keep your answers objective. Be sure your discussion includes at least three of the formal elements of art: (line, color, shape, form, composition, value, space, texture, movement, medium), as well as the artist's name and the title of the work.
