May 17, 2020: Overnight Flight

Depart from the USA.

May 18, 2020: Hague

Arrive in Amsterdam! ACIS provides you with a private coach transfer into the city center. Enjoy free time for breakfast and begin getting acquainted with this 17th century European superpower. Then continue to the Hague and your group leader arranged activities. Please note that dinner is not included today. (B)

May 19, 2020: Hague

This morning ACIS provides a private coach bus for visits of the courts as arranged by your group leader. Tonight a Welcome Group Dinner is included at the Restaurant School. (B,D)

May 20, 2020: Hague

Today is free to visit the courts with your ACIS provided coach bus. (B)

May 21, 2020: Brussels

Today pack your belongings as you prepare for departure for Brussels. Upon arrival spend the afternoon visiting the courts as arranged by your group leader. (B)

May 22, 2020: Paris

This morning enjoy your time in Brussels, before an evening transfer by metro to the train station for your journey to Paris. Transfer by public transportation to your Paris hotel. Please note that a 3 Day Paris Visite Card has been included during your stay. (B)

May 23, 2020: Paris

Today Paris is at your fingertips. Using your Visite Paris card explore the city at your own pace. (B)

May 24, 2020: Paris

Continue to enjoy the many sights of Paris. (B)

May 25, 2020: Strasbourg

This morning drive across the French countryside to Strasbourg. Enroute stop in the beautiful area of Champagne. Visit Reims where the French kings were crowned. Continue to Strasbourg. (B)

May 26, 2020: Strasbourg

Free day for court visits as arranged by your group leader. There will be an ACIS provided coach for your use. (B)

May 27, 2020: Heidelberg

This morning take part in your final court visit before traveling to Heidelberg for a free afternoon. (B)

May 28, 2020: Departure

Transfer to the airport for return flight to the United States.

of those that traveled in middle school or high school continued their studies at the college level compared to the national average of 68%



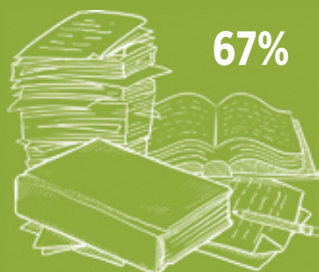
of travelers who went on to college said their travel experience influenced their field of study.

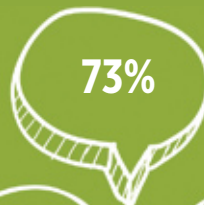
